

- Close collaboration of major stakeholders through non statutory CASP committee driving strategic development in the Greater Cork area



A bit of history




- For centuries the city docks were the focus for trade, industry & jobs




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Current Port Constraints






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RELOCATION SITE – LOWER HARBOUR


Port Relocation- Opportunities

- Port can fulfil its potential to develop as a port of strategic importance




